Tech Talk:

How does Soundroom Productions use the iPad as a “soundboard” to hence allow efficient checks of stage setups?

Via the MacBook Pro laptop we set up our own network that can be done simply through the dropdown menu shown when hovering over the Wi-Fi icon on the laptop’s top right hand corner.

When this icon is selected the staff can proceed to create the network and add the soundboard as a device to this newly formed network.

When you transfer to the iPad device the network created on the Macbook should be detected and selected. Connect is quite simple with or without a password as it is simply a matter of selecting the newly named network created.

After the necessary procedures to access the soundboard software is followed on iPad after connecting to the network, staff can now successfully access the soundboard and have mobility in an entire area to check the sound for any client’s stage setup.

How is Soundroom Productions a “cut above” the rest of the competition?

Since the early 2000s the industry of audio/visual had a standard for its signal transmission. This was the VGA(video graphics array) signal which was used specifically for projectors. But with the advent of High Definition in the industry in the late 2000s of course the standard had to change and Soundroom Productions didn’t delay to become as up to date with this revolutionizing change. HDMI connection for projectors allow for 75% clearer transmission than VGA hence giving the audience a clear, “crisp” view of all the information you want to visualize.
